***Summer Employment Opportunities for ICE Program**
Applications due: March 13, 5:00 p.m., 210A5 Engineering Hall

The College of Engineering is looking for Resident Counselors and Classroom Assistants for the ICE Program. Resident Counselors (RCs) act as resident advisors and team leaders for a group of 6-8 participants in the program. All RCs are required to live in the dorm. The weekly workload is approximately 25 hours including the weekend. Ideal candidates are either graduate or upper-class engineering students who are in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.75 or higher. Previous counseling experience is preferred but not necessary.

Classroom Assistants work with course instructors by attending classes and leading evening study sessions 3 times a week. The workload is approximately 10-15 hours per week. An ideal candidate must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and must have at least earned an A- in the course they wish to tutor.
