The fourth annual campus-wide Undergraduate Research Symposium gives undergraduates the opportunity to present the fruits of their research, scholarly, and other creative endeavors—especially those undertaken with mentorship from faculty.

Over 200 students were on last year's symposium program: 111 delivered oral presentations on panels with peers who share their academic interests, and 96 presented posters that summarized research findings. Over 140 faculty members, postdoctoral fellows, and doctoral students served as

mentors to the undergraduates on last year's symposium program; 20 mentored more than one student on the program. We are hoping that even more students and mentors will participate in the 2011 symposium.
